

## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS FOR THE FIM X-TRIAL WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

### ANNOUNCEMENT

The Club **Nouveau Moto-Club de Munster** and the promotion company **Esdeux Organisation** are organising the **1<sup>st</sup> round** of the FIM X-Trial World Championship on behalf of the **Fédération Française de Motocyclisme**. The event will be held in accordance with the Sporting Code of the FIM together with relevant Appendices, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions, approved by the Referee. The event must respect the FIM Environmental Code.

The event will be held on **Friday 13 January 2012** at **Zenith of Strasbourg (Eckbolsheim, France)**.

## **1. ENTRIES**

Entries for the whole Championship or for one event must be made on the official entry form and sent to the CTR Administration at the FIM headquarters. All entries must be received by **Wednesday 28 December 2011**.

All riders must have their entry endorsed by their federation.

The number of admitted riders for the qualification is **8** including the 8 fixed riders of the championship.

## **2. TECHNICAL CONTROL AND REGISTRATION**

The administrative and technical control will take place on **Thursday 13 January 2012** between **2pm and 4pm**.

Each machine must comply with all the requirements of Art. 057.9.1 of the FIM Trial rules. At the technical control, the rider must submit his valid FIM World Championship rider's licence, together with his helmet.

## **3. SPONSORS**

## **4. STARTING ORDER**

The starting time and starting order will be established according to Art. 057.8.3. and to the arrangements below:

The first rider for the qualification will start at: **5 pm**

The first rider for the Trial will start at: **9 pm**

Starting order for the qualification in accordance with Art. 057.8.3.1.

Starting order for the Trial in accordance with Art. 057.8.3.2.

## **5. COURSE**

At the qualification, there will be **5** normal sections.

At the Trial, there will be at least **7** normal sections and **1** double lane section.

## **6. TIME ALLOWANCE**

Qualification: the time allowance for each rider will be **7 minutes**.

The time penalty will be 1 point for each 30 seconds, or part thereof, in excess of the allowed time.

Trial: the time allowance for each rider will be decided by the Referee.

The time penalty will be 1 point for each 30 seconds, or part thereof, in excess of the allowed time.

## **7. QUALIFICATION FOR THE TRIAL**

The format of the qualification will be **one rider passing all sections in a row**.

The 6 best riders of the qualification will participate in the Trial.

## **8. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE**

In case of technical incidents, riders must immediately use their second motorcycle. No extra time shall be granted for changing motorcycle (Art. 057.9.4).

## **9. DECISION BETWEEN THE TIES**

Qualification: the decision between the ties will be made according to Art. 057.14.1.

Trial: the decision between the ties will be made according to Art. 057.14.2.

## **10. RESULTS**

The classification will be established according to Art. 057.12.

## **11. PRIZES**

Trophies will be awarded, on the podium, to the first 3 riders. The payment of financial awards will be made according to Art. 057.15.2.

## **12. VISIT OF THE SECTIONS AND INFORMATION MEETING**

The visit of the sections will take place 4 hours before the beginning of the qualifications and will be followed by the information meeting.
